

# PHYSICAL HEALING MINISTRY 1 SYLLABUS SAMPLE

Welcome to the **Christian Healing Certification Program** (CHCP) provided and sponsored by Global Awakening (GA). Physical Healing Ministry is one of three certification courses offered by GA, the other two being: deliverance and inner healing (referred to throughout the history of the Church more often as “Soul Care”). These courses are provided to equip the body of Christ in areas of healing ministry.

This first course in physical healing is based upon the experience of many people who have had a strong physical healing anointing. The majority of the videos presented are based upon the following five criteria:

1. The story of how they were called and major events or experiences.
2. How they grew and developed further in the area of healing and miracles.
3. What the breakthrough events in their life were that caused them to see more healing and miracles.
4. How they developed the ability to see and/or hear the Holy Spirit’s leading.
5. Stories of the most miraculous healings and/or deliverances they experienced.

### Required Activities:

**Words of Knowledge** – The student will submit a total of three case study reports after giving three words of knowledge for physical healing. Case study reports will be submitted in weeks 5, 6, and 7. These words of knowledge should be presented directly to people they minister to using the model learned from their course work. Students should document the words given, their accuracy, and the results.

**Five Step Prayer Model** – The student will pray for four people directly for physical healing during their eight week semester. Students will submit a total of three case study reports after using the five step prayer model. These reports will be submitted in weeks 5, 6, and 7. Their ministry should use the model learned from their course work. Student should document these prayer times and results of the healing prayers.

### Case Study Guidelines:

Case studies are a process or record of research in which detailed consideration is given to the development of a particular person, group, or situation over a period of time. Case studies for words of knowledge and five step prayer model may be presented in the same document if the word of knowledge and five step prayer model are used for the same person. If this is the case, then the prayer for one person would count for 1 case study of words of knowledge and 1 case study of five step prayer model.

If two different people are involved, please prepare separate documents (one per person). Each document should be in Microsoft Word 2003 or higher. Font should be Times New Roman, and font size should be 12. Each case study should be about 2 pages single-spaced.

Case studies should be presented in chronological order (as the event itself took place). At least two references should be made, per case study, to videos or books from the course.

Once completed, upload your attachment to the discussion question. This can be done easily when you click on “Add a new discussion topic.” When you are in the discussion thread, go to the Attachment box and click on “+Add.” You can then browse for your file and upload it when you post your answer.

#### **WEEK 1**

**Watch** the following videos:

**Read** the following material:

*Ministry Team Training Manual*, Introduction, Chapters 1-3.

**Respond** to the following discussion questions posted in the weekly outline.

**Q1 is due Tuesday by midnight EST**  
**Q2 is due Thursday by midnight EST**  
**Q3 is due Sunday by midnight EST**

Q1 Introduce yourself and tell us where you are from, what you do or occupation, and what you hope to get out of the course.

Q2 From Bill Johnson’s interview of Dr. Clark, discuss how Dr. Clark developed the ability to see and/or hear the Holy Spirit.

From Dr. Clark’s interview of Bill Johnson, discuss the most miraculous healings that Bill Johnson has seen. What preceded these healings?

Q3 Discuss what a ministry prayer team needs. What needs should you pray for and why?

Discuss in your own words how to pray both individually and in a group setting.

Video 11– David Hogan: Testimony (David Hogan is a missionary in war torn Mexico and has a unique ministry. His life is very unconventional, but he walks in the miraculous and has a passionate heart.)

*Ministry Team Training Manual*, Chapter 11, Deliverance Appendix 1-3.

**Note:** Even though CHCP offers a separate course on deliverance, this section of the manual is presented now because deliverance is sometimes necessary for physical healing to occur.

**Respond** to the following discussion questions posted in the weekly outline.

**Q10 & Q11 are due Thursday by midnight EST**  
**Q12 & Q13 are due Sunday by midnight EST**

- Q10 In David Hogan’s testimony, what did he share that most spoke to your life? How does your journey (or the journey of someone you know) relate to that of David Hogan?
- Q11 Discuss three insights from the *Biblical Basis for Healing* that you can use to support your prayers for physical healing.
- Q12 Describe how deliverance was central to the ministry of Jesus. Use biblical passages to support your argument.
- Q13 **Case Study #1** – Submit one case study for words of knowledge and one for using the five step prayer model. Type in MS WORD 2003 or higher (or Mac equivalent), using Font style: Times New Roman, Font size: 12. Once completed, upload your document to the discussion question. When you are in the discussion thread, go to the Attachment box and click on “+Add”. Browse for your file and upload it as your answer.
